AMBER GLENN

Contestant on ABC's "Dancing with the Stars"

Amber Glenn is an Olympic gold medalist and three-time U.S. national champion who has become one of the leading American figure skaters of her generation. She is the 2024-2025 Grand Prix Final champion and one of the few women in the world to land a triple axel in competition. In 2026, she helped Team USA win Olympic gold in the figure skating team event and became the first U.S. woman to land three triple axels at a single Olympic Games, while also delivering a powerful comeback performance in her Olympic free skate.

As the first openly LGBTQ+ U.S. women's figure skating champion, Glenn has used her platform to advocate for visibility, inclusion and mental health support. Glenn's 2026 Olympic season marked a career-defining breakthrough, earning her global recognition as both an Olympic champion with elite technical skill and as a trailblazing figure known for her powerful story of perseverance and visibility.
