

## 'TAMRON HALL' DEBUTS GROUNDBREAKING SEASON 7 ON MONDAY, SEPT. 8

Two-Time Emmy-Winning Host Tamron Hall Returns as Host and Executive Producer of Second Longest-Running Syndicated Talk Show Produced by Disney Entertainment

The nationally syndicated daytime show "Tamron Hall" will make its triumphant return for a highly anticipated seventh season on Monday, Sept. 8. (Check local listings.) Hosted and executive produced by Emmy®-winning Tamron Hall, the daily talk show's forthcoming season kicks off with can't-miss, star-studded exclusive interviews with Meagan Good and Jonathan Majors, Priscilla Presley, Jodie Turner-Smith, the Chrisley family, Cam Newton, Christian Siriano and more. Stay tuned for more incredible guests throughout the season, as the show broadcasts from its state-of-the-art studio located at The Walt Disney Company's new NYC headquarters.

With Season 7 — often known as the "lucky number" — Tamron Hall celebrates stories of resilience, determination, and people making their own luck. In 2025, the daytime talk show received a NAACP Image Award nomination, celebrated its 1,000<sup>th</sup> episode, and cemented its place as the second-longest-running syndicated talk show produced by Disney Entertainment.

"As we launch Season 7 of the 'Tamron Hall' show, I am deeply grateful to our loyal TamFam audience, ABC, Disney and the many stations across the country who make this journey possible. This season promises our biggest exclusives yet—featuring not only today's most celebrated names but also extraordinary people with unforgettable stories that remind us why we gather here every day," said Tamron Hall.

Reaching over 44 million total viewers in its sixth season, "Tamron Hall" consistently ranks among the top three most-watched talk shows in syndication, and among the top five of all daytime syndicated shows.\*\* The show also added several new markets for the 2025/2026 season, including Tulsa, Oklahoma; Tucson, Arizona; Wichita, Kansas; Charleston/Huntington, West Virginia; and Jackson, Tennessee, covering more than 94% of the country on all the leading broadcast groups. Tamron Hall is also available on ABC's eight owned television stations, including WABC-TV New York, KABC-TV Los Angeles, WLS-TV Chicago, WPVI-TV Philadelphia, KGO-TV San Francisco, KTRK-Houston, WTVD-TV Raleigh-Durham and KFSN-TV Fresno, which are collectively No. 1 across all U.S. television households.

"The show has become a destination for loyal viewers across the country, driven by Tamron's relatable sense of fun, warmth and style," said Almin Karamehmedovic, president of ABC News. "Our station partners recognize the incredible uniqueness of the show and the Tamron Hall team is excited to produce the biggest new season yet."

Since its debut in September 2019, "Tamron Hall" continues to be one of television's top-rated daytime shows, consistently delivering standout moments that become central to the cultural conversation. Season 6 highlights included interviews with such powerhouse guests as Deion Sanders, Cynthia Erivo, Miranda Lambert, Kelsey Grammer, Mary J.
