‘This Week’ Beats CBS in Total Viewers and Adults 25-54 for the 14th Straight Season

2024-2025 Season

For the 2024-2025 season, “This Week with George Stephanopoulos” **ranked as the No. 1 Sunday public affairs program in Total Viewers** (2.480 million), **leading NBC’s “Meet the Press”** (2.421 million) **by 59,000** and **CBS’ “Face the Nation”** (2.467 million) **by 13,000**, based on Most Current Data from Nielsen Media Research.

- In fact, “This Week” **ranked No. 1 in Total Viewers for the 4th consecutive season** — since the 2021-2022 season.
- In addition, “This Week” (2.480 million and 407,000, respectively) **outperformed CBS’ “Face the Nation”** (2.467 million and 403,000, respectively) **in both Total Viewers and Adults 25-54 for the 14th straight season** — since the 2011-2012 season.

George Stephanopoulos is anchor, Martha Raddatz is chief global affairs correspondent and co-anchor, and Jonathan Karl is chief Washington correspondent and co-anchor of “This Week.”
