Today, ABC News Studios announced that the third season of its hit true crime docuseries “Betrayal,” based on the No. 1 true crime podcast of the same name, begins streaming on **Tuesday, Sept. 2**, only on [Hulu](#) and Hulu on Disney+. “**Betrayal: Under His Eye**” follows Stacey, a single mother whose whirlwind romance with charming physician Dr. Justin Rutherford seemed like a dream come true. The couple married, moved into a beautiful new home, and began creating what felt like a picture-perfect life together—until the discovery of a hidden camera in the family’s home unearthed dark secrets. Stacey was forced to confront a devastating betrayal that shook her family to its core.
