Newton's additional credits include the Disney Channel series "Sydney to the Max" and "BUNK'D" as well as "Danger Force," "Night Court" and, most recently, the voice of Tigger in Disney Jr.'s "Playdate with Winnie the Pooh" and "Me & Winnie the Pooh."
